The student must be a resident of or attend college in the Delaware Valley area (Greater Philadelphia area including Southern New Jersey and Northern Delaware).

The applicant must also exhibit significant financial need and should note their current total educational debt. This determination **must** be addressed, or the application will not be considered. A letter from the financial aid office will usually suffice. Scholarship finalists may be asked to provide verification of total educational debt.

The application for scholarships must include the following material:

An introductory letter written by the candidate, introducing him/herself and explaining his/her current curriculum and professional goals. The letter should also include a brief background and provide the trustees with a flavor of the individual and his/her experiences and long-term goals.

A resume reflecting the standard education and work history, but we would like them to also include any extracurricular activities and service projects in which they have participated. Service work is very important.

A letter of recommendation from the Dean of the school in which the student is enrolled (please include GPA).

This packet of information should be forwarded directly to Marie Solano-Mascia at the Foundation's address no later than **October 15, 2018**. The decision will be made by **October 25, 2018** and the winning applicant will be notified via communication directly to the school. **All the material requested will be used as part of the selection process.**

The scholarship recipients will be acknowledged at our 20th Annual Awards Banquet to be held on **Wednesday November 14th, 2018 – 5:30 PM** at the Sheraton Society Hill, One Dock Street in Philadelphia, PA.
